The University of Angers (UA) is in the heart of the historic Loire Valley in western France. It has three campuses in Angers (Belle-Beille, St Serge, and Santé), and branches in the nearby towns of Cholet and Saumur. Of its 22.000 students, around 2500 are international students.

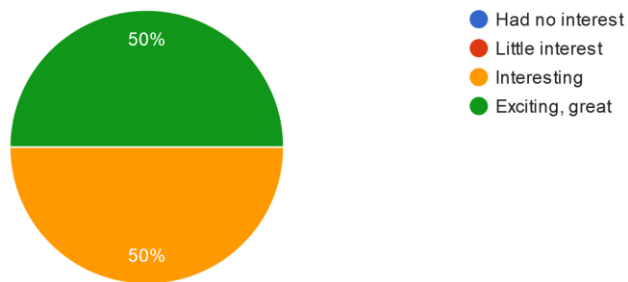

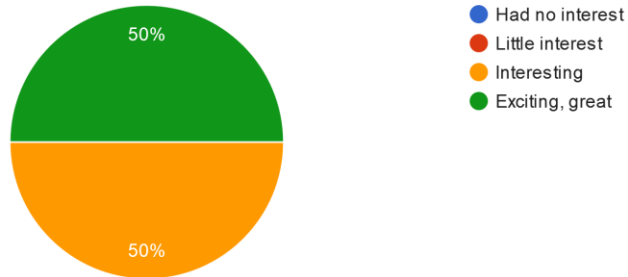

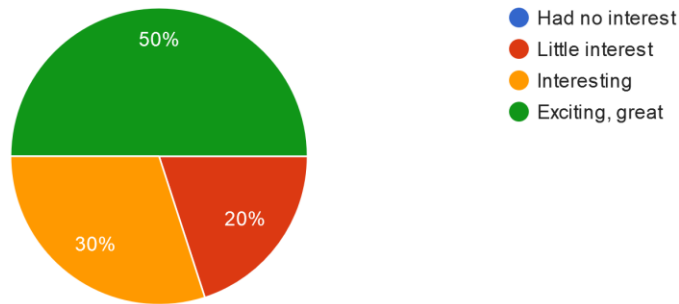

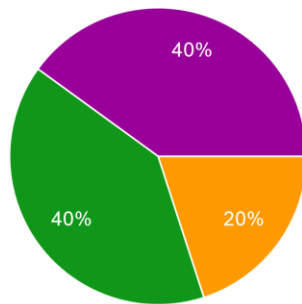

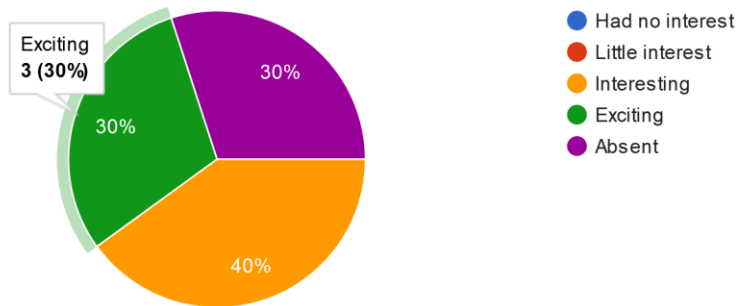
